Water Trustees

Financial Report Highlights

Water sales are starting to turn with a favorable month of May bringing variance to budget down to \$5k YTD. We received a catchup payment for cell tower rent from the lessee who had been paying the wrong amount, other revenue variances appear to be timing. Employee related expenses are down for labor and benefits due to timing of hires, vacancies and lower health claims. The overage at the UV Plant is the timing of the quarterly bill to Lewiston. Capital spending is picking up with the startup of the Poland Road main replacement project. Costs for the new vacuum unit will be shared with sewer district once finalized. Cash on hand is \$927k.

Water Quality Update

Lake quality is very good at this time. Lake sampling indicates that phosphorus levels are at normal background levels; dissolved oxygen is in the 9-10mg/l level from top to bottom. Secci disk readings have been around the 8 meter level, and turbidity for the month of May averaged 0.66.

Lead and copper sampling is going quite well, as we have received 28 of the 30 samples we need for compliance. The samples will be sent to the lab. Results will be available at the July Trustee meeting.

Project Updates

We conducted an in-house alum application meeting on Tuesday, June 11 in preparation for the treatment that is scheduled to occur on or around July 8. Items discussed included public notification, logistics, and contingency planning.

The pipe bursting portion of the Poland Water Main Replacement Project has been completed. After chlorination and pressure testing, water services will be installed, and we will transition to the dig/replace phase of the project.

Executive Session

There will be an executive session for to discuss a personnel issue.

Sewer Trustees

Financial Report Highlights

Metered income is now \$20k ahead of budget with consumption gallons up 8% over prior year. Industrial surcharges continue to trail behind. Labor and benefits are favorable YTD and overall expenses are favorable by \$28k. Capital spending continues slow and the I&I study work has begun. Cash at end of May is \$1.7 million.

Project Update

On Tuesday, June 11 a Clean Water Master Plan Update meeting was held with the DEP. They were briefed about the report that will be submitted later this month. The information discussed at the meeting will be shared in greater detail with the Trustees.

PFAS Update

LAWPCA is looking for alternatives to landfilling its biosolids. Re-opening the compost facility will be strongly considered.

We are looking to apply the consent agreement fine of \$32,500 towards the modification of catch basins on Rt 4.

Cost Apportionment

Cost apportionment is tracking very closely to the budgeted amount, with a slight amount in our favor.

Members present: Dan Bilodeau, Robert Cavanagh, K. C. Geiger, Jason Pawlina, Mary Sylvester (President) and Andrew Titus. Also present: Sid Hazelton, Superintendent and Mike Broadbent, Assistant Superintendent. Excused absence: Tizz Crowley.

APPROVE MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING of April 17, 2019 -

On motion of Andrew Titus, seconded by Dan Bilodeau, it was voted: **To unanimously accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting as amended.**

FINANCIAL REPORT UPDATE -

Water sales continue to be lower than projected due to a cool wet spring. Cash on hand is currently at \$1,081,206.20.

On motion of K. C. Geiger, seconded by Robert Cavanagh it was voted: **To unanimously accept the Financial Report as written.**

RATIFY PAYMENT OF BILLS -

On motion of Robert Cavanagh, seconded by K.C. Geiger it was unanimously voted: **To ratify the payment of bills in the amount of \$285,766.30 as shown on the printout dated April 1, 2019** – **April 30, 2019.**

PUBLIC OPEN SESSION – Closed due to no response.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

ACTIVITY REPORT – The construction season is in full swing, The Fifth Street main is installed and all customers that were on temporary water feeds have been restored to permanent water connections. A short section of Gill Street was included in the main replacement where it crosses Gill to the intersection. The Poland Road main replacement is underway.

New connections include: Bangor Savings Bank, Gracelawn and Hampshire Street Apartments. The Spring hydrant flushing is ongoing and will be completed by the end of June. Service repairs that have built up over the winter are being completed as time permits.

Both dump trucks broke down and one of them had to get towed due to ECM board failure. While one truck was parked at the repair shop it was hit. The collision repair will be covered by the company who hit the truck and will take a week to complete.

WATER QUALITY UPDATE – The water quality is very good. The weather is favoring water quality with the lack of sun. Ice out was April 22, 2019. The docks and buoys are in and boat inspections are underway. Boat inspections are funded through a Grant.

In-lake sampling has resumed. The turbidity is good and phosphorus readings are normal.

PROJECT UPDATE – PLC panel upgrades: the existing, outdated chlorine and Ph. analyzers at Court Street do not communicate with the new panel. The District is asking for Board approval to

purchase new analyzers

On motion of K.C. Geiger, seconded by Robert Cavanaugh it was unanimously voted: **To approve the purchase of new chlorine and Ph. analyzers.**

The contract for the alum treatment has been signed with Solitude. Applying the alum to the Lake will be a three week process. Alum is a coagulant that bonds to phosphorus and sinks. The intake will not be shut down during the application. The creation of a one page 'FAQ' type sheet would be useful in communicating with the public in a non-scientific manner.

NEW BUSINESS

REVIEW OF AWD CHARTER- KEY ELEMENTS AND QUESTIONS – The Charter explains the purpose of the District. The Trustees are public servants who have responsibilities. How is the Board doing fulfilling the purpose? President Mary Sylvester requested top five priorities, for the Board, from each of the Board members and Superintendent Hazelton. She will compile all priorities and send them to all Board members.

Organizational Chart – The Maine Drinking Water Program oversees all public drinking water supplies. The Maine Public Utilities Commission oversees the setting of rates. Missing from the chart is the Maine Bureau of Labor which oversees employee safety.

PROPOSED LAWPC APPLICATION AND APPOINTMENT PROCESS - LAWPC is made up of three representatives from AWD, three from LWD, one from Turner and one who represents: Buckfield, Hebron and Minot. President Mary Sylvester has proposed a selection process more detailed than the process included in the LAWPC by-laws.

Andrew Titus is concerned with the interview question regarding 'philosophy', and the required interview. Interviewing a candidate is an option of the Appointment Committee.

Advertise for the open position making sure the word is out in hopes to get the best candidate.

On motion of Dan Bilodeau, seconded by Robert Cavanaugh it was voted: **To table the LAWPC Appointment Process until the June 5, 2019 meeting: 5 in favor, 1 abstention.**

WEBSITE REDO – A beta version will be available to view at the regular June meeting.

MEASURING OF THE LAKE EVENT 2019— The purpose of the event is to thank the Trustees and meet other volunteers who have an impact on our community.

On motion of K.C. Geiger, seconded by Andrew Titus it was voted: **To have the event as past practice: 4 in favor, 2 opposed.**

SUPERINTENDENT ANNUAL REVIEW PROCESS 2019 – Superintendent Hazelton would like to use the same review form that is used by all employees at the District. Goals will be put in place at the time of the review.

TRUSTEE WORKSHOP PLAN FOR JUNE 5 – President Mary Sylvester collected the top five priorities from each of the Trustees and Superintendent Hazelton to review at the Workshop scheduled for June 5, 2019. Superintendent Hazelton will provide all Trustees with electronic copies of the interlocal agreements with Lewiston.

Superintendent Hazelton will prepare public notification for the workshop. The public is welcome, however, there will be no opportunity for public comment.

APPROVAL OF GRANT APPLICATION – There is a need for a contingency contract for engineering back up for the alum treatment. We have received a \$15,000 Source Water Protection Grant to be used for this purpose. The Tighe & Bond firm has submitted a \$30,000 proposal for this service. The AWD obligation is for half of the \$15,000.

On motion of Dan Bilodeau, seconded by Andrew Titus it was voted: **To approve \$6,000 (40%) for the contingency contract: 2 in favor, 4 opposed.**

President Mary Sylvester reassured the Board will address the inter-local agreements regarding the cost sharing with Lewiston starting at the workshop scheduled for June 5, 2019.

On motion of K.C. Geiger, seconded by Robert Cavanaugh it was voted: **To approve \$7,500 (50%) for the contingency contract: 4 in favor, 2 opposed.**

CHEMICAL BIDS -

On motion of K.C. Geiger, seconded by Robert Cavanaugh, it was unanimously voted: **To accept the chemical bids as proposed.**

TRUSTEE OPEN SESSION – Closed due to no response.

OLD BUSINESS

CONSERVATION COMMITTEE – Has not yet met.

AG ZONE AD HOC COMMITTEE UPDATE – Looking for public input and the workshop dates are posted on the City website.

LAWPC – Presented a Resolution to the City Council which opposed proposed amendments to the existing Ag/Resource Protection Zone Ordinance.

EXECUTIVE SESSION PER 1 M.R.S.A. 405 (6) (D) TO DISCUSS A PERSONNEL ISSUE – On motion of K. C. Geiger, seconded by Jason Pawlina it was unanimously voted: To move into Executive Session to discuss a personnel issue.

Summary of Auburn Water/Lewiston Water Interlocal Agreements

<u>Interlocal Agreement #1</u>

Lake Auburn Watershed Protection – signed June 29, 1993

Summary – Created the Lake Auburn Watershed Protection Commission. The agreement combined the watershed assets of the two utilities and provided a means for unifying efforts to ensure excellent water quality. It was a key effort in order to obtain a Waiver from Filtration under the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The funds required to support the budget shall be assessed by the board annually and apportioned equally between the AWD and City of Lewiston. The budget shall include all funds estimated to be necessary for land acquisition, water quality monitoring, watershed management and protection activities, inspection, and enforcement of watershed protection measures and regulations and associated administrative and professional costs.

Interlocal Agreement #2

Lake Auburn Intake & Water Pretreatment – signed October 3, 1997

Summary – Consolidated separate intake and chemical facilities in order to eliminate duplicity of equipment and efforts. Each utility was maintaining separate intakes and treatment equipment. Agreement created partnership to ensure efficiency.

Parties agreed to pay their own apportioned share of chemicals based upon metered usage and jointly bid on chemical purchase. Future capital improvements and expenditures shall be shared equally.

- Amendment #1 to Agreement #2 signed June 4, 2013
 Sharing a Water Treatment Plant Manager subject to a 50/50 cost sharing arrangement,
 Including all salary and benefits. Any required equipment, vehicles, or support items jointly shared as necessary.
- Amendment #2 to Agreement #2 signed November 8, 2015

 AWD and LWD will each employ one Class IV Treatment Operator. AWD will employ up to 2 additional Class IV Operators to be "on call" to cover after hour issues. LWD agrees to reimburse AWD half of the cost for the time these operators are assigned to the plant. Ongoing operational costs will continue to be shared on a 50/50 basis, such as power, heat, property & casualty insurance, etc. Operational chemicals will continue to be pro-rated based upon actual use.

Interlocal Agreement #3

Laboratory & Water Quality Testing Services – signed March 19, 1999

Summary – Consolidated each utility's water quality laboratory and testing services. Utilities were operating separate labs. The Agreement resulted in merging operations into one common lab, with shared technicians.

Interlocal Agreement #4

Shared SCADA Instrument Technician Services – executed year 2001

Summary – Created a new, joint position to oversee and maintain each utility's evolving computerized control system for operations. Technology was advancing, resulting in more computerized control of systems. An individual with special training was required, but there was no

need for each system to maintain separate staff positions. The Agreement was amended in late 2011 to add a second, shared person for additional support. Position is responsible for all programming and oversight of approximately 40 wastewater pump stations, 9 water storage tanks, and 10 water booster or pressure regulating stations. Costs are billed to each entity based upon usage.

Interlocal Agreement #5

Mutual Aid Agreement – Special Operations Team – signed October 10, 2002

Summary – Created a partnership between the two water utilities as well as the Lewiston Auburn Water Pollution Control Authority to form an internal emergency response team to response to any hazardous material releases within our common facilities. Agreement also created a Confined Space Rescue Team.

MOU for Water Quality Management Program – signed March 19, 1999

Water Quality Management shall include the following:

- Lake Auburn and Control Structures
- Watershed Protection and Management
- Treatment
- Regulatory Compliance
- Storage and Distribution
- Other issues as may develop

The total cost of services shall be determined and agreed to by AWD and LWD. The costs shall be shared equally between the two utilities with reconciliation and payment made on a monthly basis.

Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for lab & water Quality Testing

This agreement combined the lab and testing for both utilities.

AWD continues to employ a Water Quality Manger, salary and benefits to be equally borne between the two utilities. Each utility employs on Lab Tech. Annual operating costs shall be borne by AWD/LWD based upon utilization thereof. The parties shall allocate the cost of materials, supplies, chemicals, and other disposable items, and for any other directly allocable personnel cost.

MOU for Joint Sodium Hypochlorite Facility – signed February 7, 2008

AWD/LWD agree to jointly operate a new chlorination facility, converting the existing chlorine gas bulk storage building to accommodate sodium hypochlorite bulk storage. All equipment shall be owned by the respective utilities.

Fees for design of entire facility to be shared equally. Construction cost to be shared based upon pro-rata share of the total facility design, unless work is requested that is specific to the individual utility requesting the work, in which case it shall be paid entirely by the requesting utility.

For operations, each utility shall be responsible for the parts of the system that are specific to their utility, i.e. day tank, injection pump, injection lines, and sampling. Hypochlorite shall be shared by each utility based on actual metered usage.

MOU for joint UV Light Facility Design and Construction – signed June 18, 2009

Design and construction shall be 50/50. The ratio will be adjusted after construction and an agreed upon formula.

Operating costs will be borne by AWD/LWD based upon utilization thereof.

MOU for joint UV facility Phase 2&3 design, and application engineering – signed 7-27-2010

The cost of the consultant services shall be equally borne by AWD/LWD

MOU for Joint Chloramines Design and Construction – signed August 19, 2010

The cost of design and construction to be shared 50/50

MOU for joint operation of the Lake Auburn Water Ultra Violet Treatment Facility 2011

Maintenance and Operation of the Lake Auburn Facility is divided between Auburn and Lewiston as determined by past practice or previous agreements.

Start up support shared 50/50

Operational budget shared by the two utilities.

Insurance shared 50/50

Power costs shared 50/50, except for AWD's high lift pumps which shall be paid for 100% by AWD

Administration, fiscal procedures, staffing and personnel as follows:

Water Quality

- 1. Water Quality Director's one from Auburn, one from Lewiston
- 2. Water Quality Manager employed by AWD, and costs shared 50% by LWD
- 3. One Lab Technician paid by AWD and other by LWD
- 4. Supplies and materials are split between LWD & AWD in accordance with Managers records

SCADA

- 1. SCADA Tech employed by LWD & half of costs paid by AWD
- 2. When working in Auburn, position is assisted by Auburn personnel
- 3. When working in Lewiston, position is assisted by Pump Station Operator
- 4. Materials are charged to respective utility by project
- 5. Reports to Street Light Division Head

Shared Chemical Purchase

- 1. Chlorine
- 2. Fluoride
- 3. Sodium Hydroxide
- 4. Blended Orthophosphate
- 5. Aqua. Ammonia
- 6. Ammonia
- 7. Sodium Hypochlorite

Elements of New UV Facility

- 1. Low Head Pumps
- 2. Chlorine Injection
- 3. UV
- 4. Clear Well for Auburn & Lewiston
- 5. Blended Orthophosphate Injection (both)
- 6. Laboratory (both)

Disposition of Property Ownership

- 1. UV 1 jointly owned by AWD and City of Lewiston
- 2. City of Lewiston owns all the land that is at the lake
- 3. Pump Station owned by AWD
- 4. Fluoride building owned by Lewiston
- 5. Chlorine Storage owned by AWD

MOU for Joint UV light Facility Construction of Phase 2 & 3 signed March 10, 2011

Design and construction to be shared 50/50. Annual operating costs shall be borne by AWD/LWD based upon their utilization thereof. The parties shall pay their own apportioned share of chemicals and other additives, and for any directly allocable costs.

MOU for Lake Diagnostic Study - October 1, 2012

Cost to be shared between the utilities 50/50
